## Definitions at a Glance

- multicolored:** having “many” colors; colorful; polychromatic
- multi-flavored:** having “many” different flavors
- multigrain:** containing “many” grains (such as *multigrain* bread, *multigrain* cereal)
- multilane:** having “many” lanes (as in a *multilane* highway)
- multilateral:** having “many” sides (*later* = side) (describing a polygon); also describing a many-sided agreement between parties, nations, etc.
- multilayered:** having “many” layers
- multilingual:** speaking “many” languages (*lingu* = language, tongue)
- multimedia:** having “many” means of presentation, such as text, audio, visual, interactive applications (*medi* = mean, middle)
- multimillionaire:** a person who has “many” millions of dollars
- multipack:** a set of “many” items enclosed in a single pack
- multi-passenger:** having room or seats for “many” passengers
- multiplex:** an apartment building with “many” units; a large cinema with “many” screens or auditoriums (*plex* = fold; literally, a building with “manifold” units)
- multiply:** to add a number “many” times over (*ply, ple, plicit* = fold; literally, “to fold many times”); also, to bear numerous offspring (adjective: **multiple**, noun: **multiplication**)
- multipurpose:** serving “many” purposes
- multistory:** a building with “many” floors or stories; as an adjective: having many stories or floors
- multisyllabic:** having “many” (i.e., two or more) syllables; polysyllabic
- multitask:** to perform “many” tasks at the same time
- multitude:** a great number or crowd of “many” people or things
- multivitamin:** a tablet containing “many” vitamins in one
- polychromatic:** having “many” colors; multicolored
- polygon:** a geometric figure with “many” angles (and as many sides as angles) (*gon* = angle, corner)
- Polynesia:** a cluster of “many” islands in the South Pacific Ocean (see **Meet the Root Slide 68**)
- polysyllable:** a word with “many” syllables (adjective: **polysyllabic**)
- polytheism:** a religious belief in “many” gods (*the* = god) (adjective: **polytheistic**)
- polytheist:** a person who believes in “many” gods (*the* = god)
