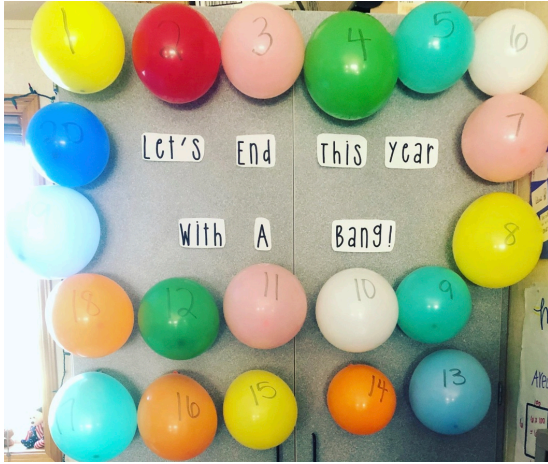


COUNTING DOWN THE DAYS 4th Grade News!
